This campaign, observed from **September 17th to October 2nd**, aligns with the vision of Mahatma Gandhi and marks the **10th anniversary of the Swachh Bharat Mission (SBM).**

Through community participation (jan bhagidari), millions have taken part in mass cleanliness campaign, environmental awareness events, and innovative waste management programs. The campaign culminates on **October 2nd, Swachh Bharat Diwas**, with nationwide celebrations paying tribute to the progress made while setting future goals for sustainable waste management.

SHS in Action: State-Level Impact

SHS 2024 united communities across India with powerful initiatives:



- Launched "Swachharpan on Gandhi's Footprints" celebrating Mahatma Gandhi's historical ties with Bihar
- 19,000 Cleanliness Target Units (CTUs) transformed as part of SHS 2024.



Madhya Pradesh

- Extensive shramdaan activities including Mohanram Pond cleanup in Shahdol.
- Honoring Safai Mitras for their contribution to cleanliness efforts.
- Over 993,324 participants across 52 districts.





- Honorable Chief Minister, Shri Eknath Shinde, led the state's efforts by participating in 'Swachhata Hi Seva'.
- A total of 13,629 cleanliness drives have been conducted, focusing on educating the public about cleanliness and the importanceof recycling.

Swachh Bharat Mission - Grameen

- Community cleanliness drives with health check-ups for sanitation workers.





- Nagaland celebrated Swachh Bharat Diwas 2024 on October 2, to mark the conclusion of "Swachhata Hi Seva" campaign 2024.
- Emphasized personal accountability with the theme "My waste, my responsibility."





- Statewide campaign launched by Chief Minister focusing on hygiene and sustainability.
- 900+ participants cleaned 20 CTUs across four districts.


