


BACKGROUND

- Co-treatment is a concept of treating Faecal Sludge along with domestic sewage at a Sewage Treatment Plant (STP).
- Haryana has total 26,87,780 rural Households, of which 11,31,430 (42%) are single leach pits and 6,90,968 (26%) are septic tanks those require regular desludging and emptying.
- Haryana state has more than 123 Urban Sewage Treatment Plants of Public Health and Engineering Department (PHED) of which 120 are currently identified as under-utilized with the possibility of co-treatment.
- Haryana has a network of unregistered and informal private de-sludgers/tankers/service providers who own desludging tanks of varying capacities (3KL to 5KL).
- On-demand service to empty the septic tanks to the households is provided at non-regularised rates by the private de-sludgers.
- There was a practice of emptying the faecal sludge tanks in the depressions, open lands, rivers, or in the outskirts of the habitations. This was a major health and environmental hazard.



Co-Treatment Units at existing Sewage Treatment Plants


Preparation for Co-treatment of Faecal Sludge (FS) in the existing or proposed (STPs)

- Co-treatment units at STPs were decided to be constructed. Drawings and designs were provided for dilution method to be adopted at every STP.
- These designs approved by the Chief Engineer PHED and circulated across the state.
- Each co-treatment unit costs approx. Rs 9-10 Lakh. **SBM (G) transferred Rs 10.8 Crore to PHED** for development of Co-treatment units.
- Technical estimates has been sanctioned for 96 co-treatment units, tenders have been floated for 91 units and 68 co-treatment units are already under construction.



Mapping of all the villages with nearest STPs

- District wise all the villages of the state were mapped with the nearest STPs.
- Villages that are more than 25 KM from the closest STPs were also identified.



Meeting and consensus on rates with private De-sludgers

- A series of workshops and meetings were organised with all the existing private de-sludgers in each district.
- Desludging operators and service owners were also trained on the ODF plus components and procedures to be followed during the desludging of Septic tanks.
- In consensus with the registered de-sludgers the rates to be charged from households are fixed ranging from **Rs 500 to 1000** for single trip for households within 5-10 Km from the closest STPs. In case of additional distance per Km charge ranging from Rs 20 to Rs 50 per KM is being fixed.





All the licensed de-sludgers have to maintain the record/logbook of the emptying and disposing of fecal sludge from households and STPs respectively.

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
Flow-Chart of Cotreatment Process

- Haryana State is trying to popularise the toll-free number 1800-180-5678 among citizens for de-sludging services of toilet pits.
- The facility will connect households with licensed desludgers in the areas.
- These licensed de-sludgers will empty the pits at fixed charges and dispose of the collected fecal matter at designated locations STPs for treatment.
